**SYMPHONY GUILD OFFERS SECOND CHANCE AT  
WALKING TOUR & OUTDOOR CONCERT AT RED FOX LANE**

The Salina Symphony Guild announces the rescheduled of its “Rite of Spring” walking tour and outdoor concert, rescheduled for Sunday, May 9, from 6-8 p.m., after its original date was called off due to rain.

Nineteen homeowners in Red Fox Lane, located on the east end of Albert Avenue in southeast Salina, have agreed to participate in the event, which will consist of various musical ensembles performing at each of the homes. The chamber musicians will include members of both the Salina Symphony and the Youth Symphony orchestras.

“People can walk through and hear the music as they enjoy the landscape plantings,” said Dana Sams, who is coordinating the event for the Guild. “It’s a beautiful setting. People will enjoy walking through there.”

CityGo buses will provide transportation from the parking lots on Ohio between Cloud and Belmont Streets to the Red Fox Lane entrance.

Tickets are \$10 for adults and \$5 for students, and may be purchased at the Bank of Tescott (Santa Fe branch), Eccentricity, The Coffee Club and Yarns. Tickets may also be purchased at the gate.

Proceeds from the fundraiser will assist the Guild in awarding summer music camp scholarships to students who participate in the Youth Symphony program.
