

Salina Youth Symphony Concerto Competition Application

The winner will perform the concerto with the Salina Symphony on May 6, 2012.

Eligibility:

1. Must be a current member of the Salina Youth Symphony.
2. Must be a Senior or Junior.

Guidelines:

1. The competition piece must be a solo work with Symphony Orchestra or string orchestra, and the length must be less than 15 minutes.
2. Students must use an accompanist for the competition.
3. Students must provide their own accompanist.
4. Students may choose to audition with their secondary instruments, including voice, but may register one only entry to the competition.
5. The competition is open to the public.
6. Three judges will be selected by the Salina Symphony.
7. The application deadline is Friday, February 24.
8. The Salina Symphony may deny the application if the orchestra parts for the concerto are not available or difficult to obtain in the United States. Please check with the Music Director before submitting the application.
9. The Salina Symphony reserves the right to select no winner or multiple winners, based on the audition results.
