SALINA YOUTH CHOIR – Conducted by Jenna Eshleman Rehearses Tuesday evenings from 6:30-8:00 p.m. in the KWU Choir Room

The Salina Youth Choir offers the opportunity for area youth to participate in a professionally-directed youth choir composed of students who are dedicated to fine music making. Auditions are open to grades 4-8. The Salina Youth Choir rehearses most Tuesday evenings (Aug. 29-Dec. 14 & Jan. 16-April 17) and performs three concerts each season.

The participation fee is \$175 per year or \$90 per semester plus the price for concert attire & t-shirt (\$95 for girls; \$80 for boys).

Payment is due on or before the parent meeting/first rehearsal on Aug. 29. (The fee will be collected on Aug. 29 following the parent meeting, or may be brought/mailed to the Symphony Office. Please note: those who prefer to pay for the entire season in September may pay a reduced price of \$175.) Failure to remit payment or make alternate arrangements by Oct. 3 (Feb. 6 for spring semester) may result in suspension from SYC until fees are paid.
