Salina Symphony Announces Youth Education Program Spring Concerts

Seating will open at 1:30 p.m. The Salina Youth Choir will also perform Sunday, April 29, at 4:00 p.m. at Junction City First Presbyterian Church with the Junction City Children's Choir. Admission is free and open to the public.

The Salina Youth Choir features 42 members under the direction of Jenna Eshleman.
