

## Salina Symphony Guild Scholarship Video/Audio Instructions

Late videos/audio recordings will not be accepted.

As part of your complete application, send an email with a link to your performance video.

Videos/Audio Recordings should be sent no later than the scholarship application deadline. \*\*

Videos do not have to be professional in nature. Cell phone videos are welcome. We prefer YouTube links.

1. The YouTube video title should have the name of the participant, the performance piece and the scholarship for which they are competing. (Merit vs Need Merit)

Example: "Suzy Q, Sonatina in G. Beethoven, Need Merit" or "Patrick M, Presto in C. Mozart, Merit"

- Please be sure your videos are set to "Public" or "Unlisted": VIDEO MANAGER → videos → Basic Info → from the drop-down menu, please choose "Public" or "Unlisted" only. Any other setting will not be available to the scholarship committee.

2. Contestants must show upper or full body and have adequate lighting to see their face and instrument as well as their full range of motion. We recommend having the recording devices 6-7 ft. away from the performer(s).

3. Audios and videos may not be edited.

\*\* If a video is unable to be produced, applicants may send a sound recording in mp3 format, or other digital format easily accessible via a link on an email to [dtcelloberquist@gmail.com](mailto:dtcelloberquist@gmail.com)

Do not send sound recordings that have been altered or edited.
